

OBJECTIVES OF THE DEEMED UNIVERSITY

(as laid down in MOA)

A GLIMPSE OF THE LUCKNOW CAMPUS

Introduction -

Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan (Deemed University) Lucknow Campus, Lucknow (Previously known as Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeeth) was established in 1986 with good efforts of Smt. Sheela Kaul, Minister of HRD, Govt. of India and full co-operation of govt. of U.P. during the tenure of Sh. N.D. Tiwari as Chief Minister. The Campus started in a rented building at B1/89, Sector-B, Aliganj, Lucknow.

Establishment of this campus in Lucknow, capital of U.P., has great significance of its own. Lucknow is a centre of traditional knowledge. Various Sanskrit scholars, academicians and literary persons of this area have contributed their mite in the field of Sanskrit. Sanskrit teaching and learning in Lucknow is highly significant in the context of - Development of Indian culture, National integration and Secular society.

Campus started functioning in its own building in 10 acres land allotted by Lucknow Development Authority at Vishal Khand-4, Gomti Nagar, Lucknow since 1994. Main building was constructed by CPWD in 2002. Campus also has boys hostel, girls hostel, principal's quarter & staff quarters.

- ♦ This campus is imparting Sanskrit Education from Prak-Shastri (intermediate) to Acharya (P.G.) on traditional Stream in Vyakarana, Jyotisha-(Siddhant and Falit), Baudha Darshan and Sahitya.

- ♦ Modern Languages and Subjects – Hindi, English, Political Science, Economics, Computer Education, Environmental Education etc. are taught alongwith traditional subjects upto graduate level.
- ♦ Research scholars are provided with guidance for the award of Vidya Varidhi (Ph.D.) degree.
- ♦ Teacher Education is imparted for the award of Shiksha Shastri (B.Ed.) degree, with intake of 100 students and the same is recognized by NCTE.
- ♦ Besides this campus conducts Non-Formal Sanskrit Education Centre in which spoken Sanskrit course namely Deeksha part 1, 2 and 3 are taught and also under Extended Education Programmes-short term Jyotish Introductory Course and Pali Certificate courses are also conducted for Students of Sansthan as well as the general public.

Goal of the Campus –

To facilitate and promote traditional and modern systems of Sanskrit Education, training and research.

Objectives of the Campus –

1. To facilitate teaching and learning of Sanskrit through traditional methods in order to preserve the rare oriental knowledge.
2. To propagate Sanskrit Education through extension activities.
3. To facilitate Sanskrit teachers training.
4. To facilitate studies of other languages and literatures which influence Sanskrit education.
5. To undertake research work in Sanskrit literature through traditional scholarship and modern techniques.
6. To edit and publish original and translated literature related to ancient and modern knowledge of Sanskrit.
7. To facilitate publication of research work and research aids like subject materials, catalogues, bibliography etc.
8. To collect preserve and publish manuscripts.
9. To undertake various schemes of Sanskrit learning awarded by the Sansthan.
10. To contribute for the composite culture of the area with traditional Sanskrit wisdom.

To produce skilled human-power with complete background of Sanskrit and to conduct research and comparative studies in Science with reference to Sanskrit.
